ATTENDANCE AT THE SALES COMPLEX COVID SAFE MEASURES

Our priority is ensuring the health and safety of all participants attending The Star Gold Coast Magic Millions Carnival. At all times our COVID safe practices will be in accordance with Queensland Health.

In accordance with the [Queensland Government's public health directions in effect from 17 December 2021](#), the 2022 Gold Coast Yearling Sale, inclusive of all inspection and auction days, will operate as a **fully vaccinated** only event.

This restriction applies to all persons in attendance, excluding children under the age of 16 or those with evidence of a medical contraindication who are unable to be vaccinated against COVID-19.

This restriction is in line with the Queensland Government's legally binding public health directions that apply to the Magic Millions Sales Complex which conducts its business activity as a hospitality venue as well as an indoor and outdoor venue. From 17 December all racemeetings in Queensland are being conducted under the same strict attendance guidelines.

MAGIC MILLIONS SALES COMPLEX ATTENDANCE CHECK LIST

1. Register your attendance at the time of **each** entry via the [Check in Qld app](#). If you can't download the app, you must register your details with the security staff at the gate or visit Reception/Sale Day Office immediately upon arrival.
2. Have proof of your fully vaccinated status (electronic or printed). [We strongly recommend you add your COVID-19 digital certificate to the Check in Qld app.](#)
3. If you are unable to receive a COVID-19 vaccination because of a medical contraindication, you must have evidence of this in the form of an online or printed immunisation history statement from the Australian Immunisation Register, including confirmation of a recorded medical contraindication by an eligible health professional.
4. If you are unwell or have symptoms consistent with COVID-19 (such as cough, fever, sore throat, fatigue, shortness of breath, loss of smell or loss of taste) please do not attend the sales complex and get tested immediately.
5. Please check **daily** Queensland Health's published [contract tracing alerts and list of exposure venues](#). If you are deemed a casual or close contact, you must not attend the sales complex until you have followed and completed the [Queensland Health rules for casual and close contacts](#).

For the purposes of these public health directions, a fully vaccinated person is an individual who is 16 years of age or older who has received two doses of an approved COVID-19 vaccine, with at least seven days post second dose.

RESTRICTIONS DO NOT APPLY TO CHILDREN UNDER THE AGE OF 16.

We ask for your cooperation and consideration of all participants to ensure a safe environment for everyone attending The Star Gold Coast Magic Millions Carnival.
