Quick Reference Guide

When scheme logos are included on a pedigree in this catalogue what do they mean?

	The lot is nominated (paid up) to the Magic Millions Race Series and therefore eligible for Magic Millions races conducted nationally for the horse's racing lifetime.
	The lot is eligible to be nominated to the Magic Millions Race Series after being offered (sold or passed in) at the 2026 Gold Coast Horses in Training Sale. Nominations must be effected by Monday 19 October 2026. Note: if the lot is withdrawn from the 2026 Gold Coast Horses in Training Sale, the horse is no longer eligible to be nominated to the MM Race Series.
	The lot is sired by a BOBS eligible stallion and is eligible to nominate to the BOBS scheme but the horse is not yet nominated. To be eligible for BOBS Silver bonuses when racing the horse as a 2YO and 3YO in NSW, owners are required to nominate for BOBS and pay the prescribed fee by 1 September of the lot's 2YO year. BOBS Double-Up vouchers can be redeemed towards the purchase of this lot. The BOBS scheme is administered by Racing NSW.
	The first payment of the QTIS registration has been processed for the lot but the horse is not yet fully registered. To be eligible for QTIS bonuses when racing the horse in Queensland, owners are required to complete the QTIS nomination and make the final payment of the prescribed fee by 30 June of the lot's 1YO year (or make late payment by 31 August of the lot's 1YO year). The lot is eligible for QTIS under Eligibility B criteria, whereby the dam of the horse was covered by a Queensland domiciled stallion in the year this lot was born. QTISx vouchers can be redeemed towards the purchase of this lot. The QTIS scheme is administered by Racing Queensland.
	The lot is fully paid up and eligible to win QTIS bonuses when racing the horse in Queensland, with no further action required. If the lot is sired by a stallion which was standing in Queensland at the time of conception, the horse is automatically fully paid up to the scheme free of charge, with no payment or nomination paperwork required. QTISx vouchers can be redeemed towards the purchase of this lot. The QTIS scheme is administered by Racing Queensland.
	The lot is nominated to Racing Rewards SA and eligible to win Racing Rewards SA bonuses when racing the horse in SA, with no further action required. The Racing Rewards SA scheme is administered by Racing SA.
	The lot is nominated to TASBRED and eligible to win TASBRED bonuses when racing the horse in Tasmania, with no further action required. The TASBRED scheme is administered by Tasracing.

	STATUS – Paid up for VOBIS Silver. ON OFFER – Race for VOBIS Silver Bonuses on all Victorian 2YO & 3YO TAB races & maidens 2000m+. BONUS – Bonuses paid to Nominator, Owner, Trainer & Jockey: 1st, 2nd & 3rd in VOBIS Silver races. UPGRADE – Upgrade to VOBIS Gold, race for additional prizemoney & bonuses. Upgrade by 30 November 2026 The VOBIS scheme is administered by Racing Victoria.
	STATUS – Progeny of a VOBIS Sires nominated stallion. REDEEM – This lot can be purchased with VOBIS Platinum vouchers, once nominated to VOBIS Silver. NOMINATE – to VOBIS Silver, race for VOBIS Silver Bonuses on all Victorian 2YO & 3YO TAB races & maidens 2000m+. UPGRADE – Upgrade from VOBIS Silver to VOBIS Gold, straight to VOBIS Platinum. Upgrade by 30 November 2026. RACES – Once upgraded, eligible for VOBIS Gold Prizemoney & Bonuses, the VOBIS Platinum Showdown & VOBIS Platinum Guineas, plus VOBIS Platinum vouchers on 250+ VOBIS Gold races. The VOBIS scheme is administered by Racing Victoria
 + 	STATUS – Progeny of a VOBIS Sires nominated stallion and paid up for VOBIS Silver. REDEEM – This lot can be purchased with VOBIS Platinum vouchers. ON OFFER – Race for VOBIS Silver Bonuses on all Victorian 2YO & 3YO TAB races & maidens 2000m+. BONUS – Bonuses paid to Nominator, Owner, Trainer & Jockey: 1st, 2nd & 3rd in VOBIS Silver races. UPGRADE – Upgrade from VOBIS Silver to VOBIS Gold, straight to VOBIS Platinum. Upgrade by 30 November 2026. RACES – Once upgraded, eligible for VOBIS Gold Prizemoney & Bonuses, the VOBIS Platinum Showdown & VOBIS Platinum Guineas, plus VOBIS Platinum vouchers on 250+ VOBIS Gold races. The VOBIS scheme is administered by Racing Victoria.
	The lot is breeder nominated to the Westspeed Standard scheme but not yet owner nominated. For the owner/s to be eligible for Westspeed Standard bonuses when racing the horse in WA, owners are required to complete the owner nomination and pay the prescribed fee by the prescribed July deadline of the lot's 1YO year. The lot is eligible for Westspeed under the criteria whereby the dam of the horse was at least 50% owned by a WA based breeder at the time of conception (as recorded in the Australian Stud Book); OR the dam of the horse was covered by a WA domiciled stallion in the year this lot was born. The Westspeed scheme is administered by Racing WA.
	The lot is breeder nominated to the Westspeed Platinum scheme but not yet owner nominated. For the owner/s to be eligible for Westspeed Platinum bonuses when racing the horse in WA, owners are required to complete the owner nomination and pay the prescribed fee by the prescribed July deadline of the lot's 1YO year. The lot is sired by a Westspeed Platinum nominated stallion, which was standing in WA at the time of conception. Westspeed Platinum owner nominated horses are eligible for substantially higher (double) bonuses compared to Westspeed Standard, as well as being eligible to compete in Westspeed Platinum Restricted Races. The Westspeed scheme is administered by Racing WA.

BOBS Extended for the Magic Millions Gold Coast Horses In Training Sale on October 12, 2026

Racing NSW has extended its nomination deadline date for the hugely successful Breeders Owners Bonus Scheme (BOBS) to include the upcoming Magic Millions Gold Coast Horses In Training Sale on October 12, 2026.

Prospective owners will now have the chance to nominate any BOBS eligible horse (**which was foaled in 2024**) purchased at this sale for BOBS SILVER and BOBS Extra without paying the late fee, despite nominations for BOBS closing on September 1, 2026.

As the trend of international buyers attending ready to run sales in Australasia increases, so too has the popularity of the sales amongst the domestic market.

Now in it's 24th year, BOBS SILVER and BOBS Extra are immensely popular. Last season 1122 BOBS SILVER wins were recorded paying out over \$8.6 million.

The closing date for BOBS registration for purchases at the Magic Millions Gold Coast Horses In Training Sale is Friday October 23, 2026.

VOBIS Nomination Deadlines Extended

Racing Victoria has extended its nomination deadline for Australia's richest Owner and Breeder's scheme, VOBIS for 2YO's purchased at the 2026 Gold Coast Horses In Training Sale.

VOBIS Silver Late Nominations will now close on the 30th of November.

VOBIS Gold / VOBIS Platinum upgrades will also now close on the 31st of December.

A VOBIS Silver nomination is the first step in ensuring your horse is eligible to race for up to \$30 million[^] on offer across the VOBIS programme each season, once nominated to VOBIS Silver your horse will be eligible to upgrade to VOBIS Gold and VOBIS Platinum.
